This comic book is filled with the adventures of me and my brother, Leo, who I love playing with. He has Dravet syndrome. Maybe you have a sibling with Dravet too?


You may be wondering — do I really exist? No! But my story is inspired by people who have agreed to share their stories of having family members with Dravet.




If you have questions or don't understand something while reading this comic book, you can ask an adult.


I can't wait for you to read my story. I hope you will like it and that it helps you!



At first, my parents had to change their work hours to help Leo during the day. For example, they have to take him to different doctor appointments and care for him when he has seizures.








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

















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













